that Mr Thorwaldson may be waiting for some
communication from her before he commences
the Model of the Monument, and she would be
extremely sorry to be the cause of any delay, for
she believes Prince Sapicha mentioned to Mr
Thorwaldson that he particularly wished Mrs
Patten Gold to see the Model on her return
to Rome, which will be on the 4th or 5th of April.
